## The Piano Chord Plate



- 1 Place the plate behind the black keys.
- 2 Align the "ROOT" column with the chord's key (e.g. C).
- 3 Find the row and squares based on chord code (i.e. A5, Gm7)
- 4 The keys to play are marked by grey squares.  
The purple-grey square can be replaced by a purple or left out.  
The green-grey square can be replaced by the green square.  
Play also a yellow square if the chord code indicates it.
